

Where is Nubble Light?

Use Google Maps to find the location of Nubble Light. Try “Cape Neddick Nubble Lighthouse” in the maps’ search bar. Once you’ve found the location of the lighthouse, get a satellite view by clicking on the small square in the lower left of the screen. A satellite view is like seeing the lighthouse from above. You can zoom in and out of the satellite view using the + and – icons on the lower right. Once you have an image you like, right click on it and select **Save image as....** Save it to your file folder titled “Nubble Light.” Also save it below on this worksheet. To do that, click on **Insert** in the top menu line, choose **Pictures**, and go to your “Nubble Light” folder. Click on the saved satellite image. It will appear on this page. You can size it and position it as you like. To do that, double click on the image. Options for size and orientation will appear in the menu line above. Choose what you want.
